- STEM lesson plans.

How do I become an EdTalk speaker or workshop presenter?

Join the STEM 2021 team!

STEP 1: Prepare your submission

To be considered as a STEM 2021 EdTalk speaker or workshop presenter, you'll need to prepare:

A 200-word summary of your EdTalk or workshop

OR

A 3 minute video outline of your EdTalk or workshop
(low-production quality is acceptable at this stage)

Only the best, most innovative EdTalk and practical workshop submissions will be chosen!

- Be sure to highlight your expertise.
- Show your enthusiasm for STEM education, innovation or future careers in your industry vertical.
- Outline the outcomes your EdTalk or workshop will offer.
- Tell us why your EdTalk or workshop should be included!

Please be mindful that all EdTalk and workshop presentations will be a maximum length of 20-minutes and a minimum length of 5 minutes. Research suggests that 15 minute presentations have the maximum impact.
